100,000<sup>th</sup> test went to Haiti to the Christianville Clinic in 2009



200,000<sup>th</sup> test went to India with Nurses for the Nations in 2012



And 3 months ago the 300,000<sup>th</sup> test went to Nicaragua with Global Health Outreach (Christian Medical and Dental Ministry) in 2014



As a ministry of CMDA, Global Health Outreach is a short-term international missions program dedicated to providing healthcare while spreading the gospel by sending medical, dental and surgical teams around the world.

Each year, they send 40 to 50 teams around the world. Through these trips, they disciple participants, grow national churches, share the gospel and provide care to the poor and needy.

GHO teams minister in outpatient primary care medicine and dentistry and in small and large hospitals to provide surgical services. They partner with those who are focused on ministering to unreached people groups in challenging areas around the world, where they share our Savior's love in deed.

Nicaragua is the Central American country with the greatest challenges in terms of spiritual, economic and health concerns. From the leader Somoza to the Sandinista Revolution, the people of Nicaragua have endured several harsh dictatorships prior to a civil war that lasted for years and deteriorated and destroyed the land. Democracy did not arrive in Nicaragua until 1990. They have enjoyed peace for the past 16 years, but they are desperately poor and in need of medical assistance.
